If it look's too good to be true, it probably is. Be careful about accepting invitations to go for food or drinks with beautiful women you meet in the street. Some bars and restaurants pay them to lure you in so they can charge you exorbitant prices.

It's easy to lose your passport, but getting a replacement is expensive and time-consuming. You need to carry ID here, but use your photo driving licence and lock your passport in your hotel safe.



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
